

Tell me about MAP sexual identity!

- Are you 19 or older?
- Do you experience sexual and/or romantic attraction to minors? (Minors are children who haven't gone through puberty, or teens who are going through puberty).

- Do you want to talk about your sexual identity, how you feel about it now, and how you have felt about it in the past?
- Do you have two hours to talk to me about your experiences?
- Are you comfortable using Zoom? It will be audio-only.

All participants will be given a fake name to protect their identity. I will not ask you any questions that could identify you. - You know the student researcher
