The Centre for Addiction and Mental Health and John Hopkins University would like to invite you to join a research study to help them evaluate the Talking for Change (TFC) Program. TFC is a secondary prevention program offering psychotherapy to individuals who are concerned about their sexual interest in children, their use of child pornography, and/or their risk to use child pornography or offend sexually against a child.

You are invited to participate in an online survey which will ask you questions about a number of topics, ranging from your emotional experiences, who you are sexually attracted to, your social life and intimate relationships, your attitudes about sexuality, and your education and employment history.

Who is eligible?

You are able to join this study if you:

- Identify as a cis gender man;
- Are 18 years or older;
- Have a sexual attraction to children 14 years of age or younger.

Participation is voluntary and anonymous.
